1. A "Heritage Defense Fund" of \$50,000 will be maintained by the Alabama Division for the purpose of timely response to heritage issues as required by the Division. The funds may only be used at the direction of the Operations Committee, The Executive Committee, or the Division Convention. These funds are to be used only in the state of Alabama.

2. All funds collected by the Alabama Division will be kept in trust until the end of the fiscal year. At the beginning of each fiscal year, the trust fund amounts, along with their interest, will be combined with any carry over amounts for use in the Division Budget. Interest amounts earned from the Life Membership Fund will remain with the corpus of the respective fund. Interest amounts earned from the Division Library Fund will be used to purchase additional books and other media for the Division Library.

3. 10% of the funds the Division receives for SCV car tags will be donated each fall to the Alabama State Archives for the purpose of the conservation of the Confederate flags in the State Archives Collection.

4. The Alabama Division will offer as many as three educational scholarships a year each in the amount of \$1500.00. This scholarship will be known as the Lt. General Joseph Wheeler Scholarship and the 1st Lt. Commander shall serve as the Chairman of the committee that will assemble each year to award the scholarship. The application and guidelines will be posted on the Division website or can be obtained by contacting the Alabama Division 1st Lt. Commander.

5. The Alabama Division Operations Committee will send out the first renewal notice for dues no later than the 15th of May each year utilizing the Membership Renewal System (MRS). The notice will include a payment stub and a windowed envelope; such that the envelope will be delivered to the member's camp adjutant.
